Thank you so much for your interest in fundraising on behalf of The Jansen's Foundation. We are a non-profit 501(c)(3) dedicated to finding a cure for Jansen's Metaphyseal Chondrodysplasia (JMC), an ultra-rare debilitating skeletal disease.

The good news is that The Jansen's Foundation is making great progress toward our goal for a cure. An amazing team of researchers from Massachusetts General Hospital and Harvard Medical School in Boston have not only identified the gene responsible for the disorder, but a means for overriding the impact of the genetic mutation. The preclinical-stage test results are promising enough that an application for human drug trials is ready for submission.

In addition to our pursuit for a cure, The Foundation is busy with a two-pronged education and outreach program. The global outreach program strives to identify more undiagnosed JMC sufferers. While there are fewer than 30 people in the world who have been diagnosed with JMC, five of them have been identified since the creation of The Foundation. We are sure there must be more people out there who, much like our founder, have spent years — even decades — searching for answers.

The second area of concentration is education. We are currently developing a forum for leading researchers, medical professionals and therapists to share their research and provide resources for managing the pain and complications associated with JMC.
